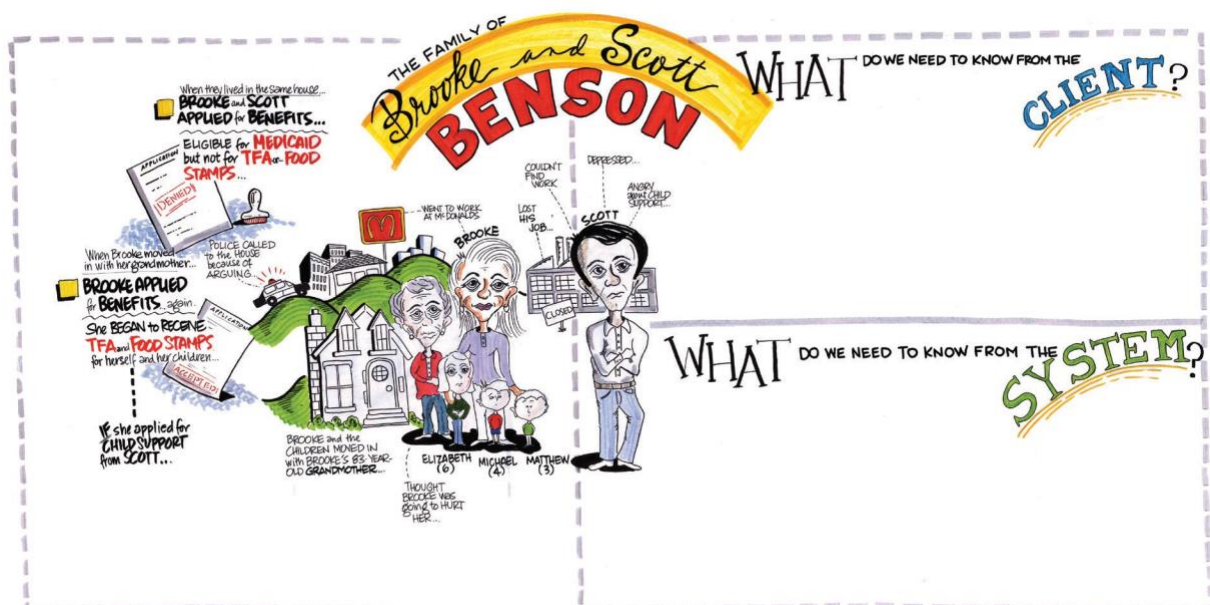
This guide will help you navigate your way through the Interoperability Gallery. The 30 murals we've chosen for this first-of-its-kind exhibit represent a small percentage of those we've created over the years to capture learning and tell a variety of stories. We've arranged the murals to highlight key themes and topics to stimulate thinking, questions and dialogue. Each one has a description attached detailing the event and session from which it originated. They're all linked to a page on our website where you can find related murals and other assets, including videos of the sessions and accompanying presentations.

Each of the Gallery's four rooms focuses on diverse topics organized to facilitate conversations with colleagues and subject matter experts. We've also incorporated interactive activities, both for fun and so you can share your knowledge, observations and recommendations. These responses will be summarized in a new mural that our acclaimed graphic artist, Anthony Weeks, will create with attendees. After the summit, we will distribute copies to all attendees to share with colleagues and friends!

You'll meet "docents" throughout the Gallery during the two guided tours we're offering. These subject matter experts have graciously agreed to answer questions, discuss a range of topics, and help you "see" some of the visual thinking embedded in the murals.

Each guided tour ends with a brief "Ignite" presentation and Q&A focused on a compelling subject that isn't addressed in any of the summit's workshops. (See schedule for specific topics and presenters.) The Gallery will also be open for attendees to visit at their leisure at various times during the summit without a guided tour.

**Room 1: The Interoperability Journey.** A brief overview of our 15-year interoperability journey. We include some key highlights and milestones that have informed our path, as well as the field more broadly.

**Room 2: Interoperability in Action.** Murals that focus on key domains and change drivers associated with information-sharing, as well as examples of early-adopter organizations that have implemented interoperability strategies and plans. Here, you can dive into and explore factors that are critical to success.

**Room 3: Tools You Can Use.** Key methods and models that Stewards of Change has developed working with leading jurisdictions and thought leaders nationwide. They provide a conceptual framework and practical approaches for building individual and organizational capacity to design, implement and sustain change. Examples include organizations we've helped develop vision plans, actionable strategic roadmaps and innovative programs. Learn more about these tools so you can use them back home.

**Room 4: What's Next.** Interactive activities through which you can contribute your ideas and recommendations on our Ideation Board; our graphic artist will then incorporate them – as you watch into a mural envisioning the future of interoperability. This room is also where we can document your thoughts in video interviews and/or on social media, and where you can engage in conversations with summit organizers, presenters, leaders and colleagues – including our Gallery sponsor, the EP3 Foundation.

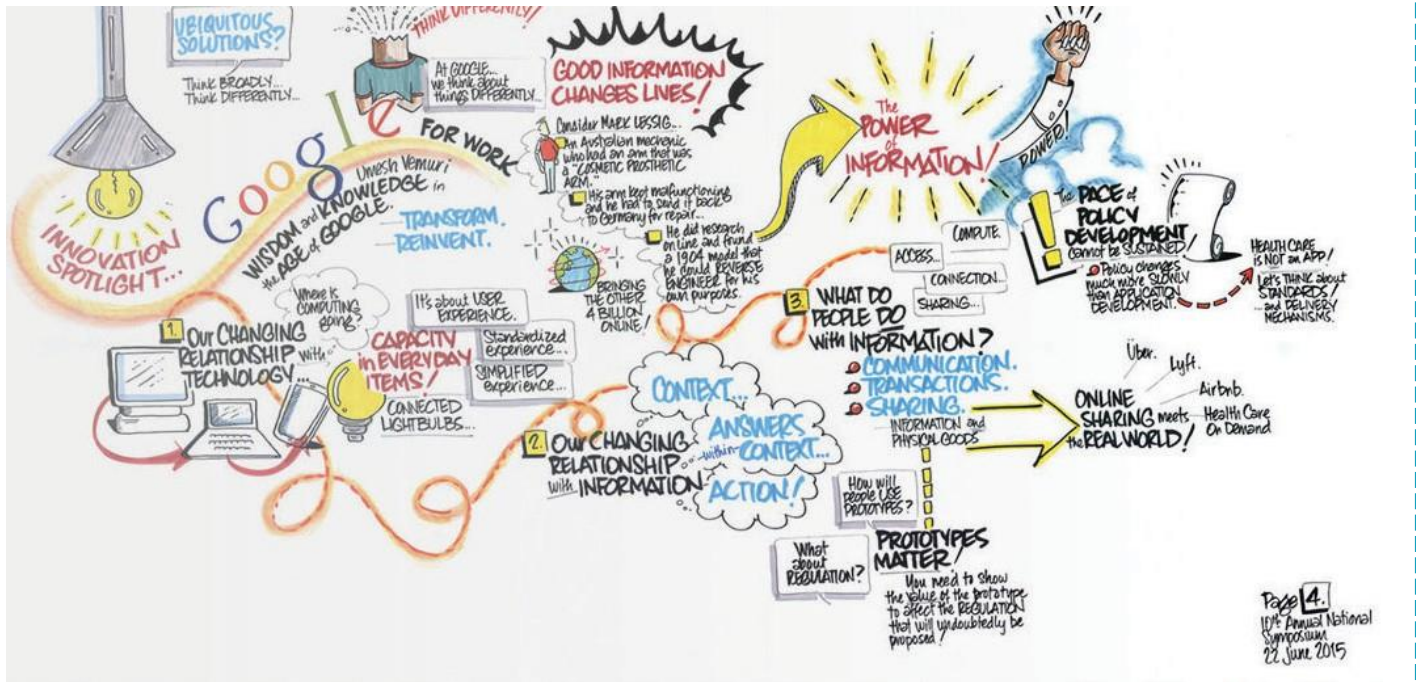
